 <p>Grape Hyacinth Muscari naturalizes in well-draining soil and in full to partial sunlight. You'll need about nine bulbs per square foot. Bulb size: 9 cm/up. Full to partial sunlight. Bloom time in horticultural zone 5: April/May. Plant 5" deep and 3" to 4" apart. HZ: 4-8. Height: 8".</p>	\$3 for 6 bulbs		
 <p>Dutch Rainbow Iris Dutch Iris are one of the most highly used flowers late spring and early summer floral arrangements. This stunning mixture includes purple, lavender, blue, yellow and white varieties. Bulb size: 8 cm/up. May/June. HZ: 5- 8. 18" to 22".</p>	\$3 for 6 bulbs
